<b>Tribe A</b> <b>Junga-mungas</b> 	<b>Tribe B</b> <b>Blocktrots</b> 	<b>Tribe C</b> <b>Ocean Wavers</b> 
Jungle, shelter made of branches in trees	Urban, house	Island, caves near sea
It is impolite to shout, so whisper even if people cannot hear you.  Do not raise your voice.  Smile constantly.  Frequently jump up and down beating your chest.	Greet others by touching thumbs.  Find close contact offensive.  Usually keep hands behind their back.	Jump in before others have finished their sentences.  It is rude to hold back your thoughts.  Use very direct eye contact.

<b>Tribe D</b> <b>Allaballa</b> 	<b>Tribe E</b> <b>Nomadom</b> 	<b>Tribe F</b> <b>Shiveroos</b> 
Small shelters made of goat skin in desert	Temporary dwelling, whatever is available for the night	Snow dwellers, igloo, ice formed in dome shape
Do not have eye contact.  Women never touch men in any way.  Essentially reserved and shy by nature	Always look towards the ground.  No eye contact.  Smiling is not considered polite.  Men and women have no contact.	Rapidly blink eyes to show friendliness.  Greet each other by touching the others feet.  Very outgoing, considered polite to make first contact with others.
