Strategies

1

Stage an art installation reflecting individual identities of whole school community.

2

Hold a school community 'Picnic for the Human Race'.

3

Develop a sequence of lessons to support teaching and learning prior to the art installation and picnic.

4

Model student activities from lesson plans for teachers at staff meetings.



Goal

For students, teachers and families to develop a greater appreciation of their own cultural identity and that of others within the wider community. Our aim is that 90% of school community members will be able to articulate and demonstrate respect for their own cultures and those of others by the end of 2021.
