You're invited to express interest in participating in our National Youth Summit - a platform for students to voice their ideas around diversity, inclusion and community cohesion to politicians, leaders and the broader community.

Who can participate?

Secondary schools from across Australia are invited to participate. Schools will be selected to represent the diversity of Australian schools.

What preparation is required?

Selected schools will form teams of 3-4 students to develop a presentation / proposal on:

- building awareness of a topic related to this year's theme
- providing a solution to address an issue related to the theme

Student proposals will be presented to other participating schools, community leaders and politicians at the Summit. Presentations will be followed by a Q&A with politicians and other leaders.

What is the Youth Summit theme?

The National Youth Summit theme is 'Growing belonging in a disconnected world.'

What will it cost?

The Summit day is a **FREE** experience for students. Travel costs can be subsidised.
