






All modules are linked to the listed year levels of the Australian Curriculum V9. This can be used as a guide for the accessibility and suitability of a module.








The modules are colour-coded:







- Blue for Primary-linked, with light blue for mid Primary and dark blue for upper Primary

To assist teachers, you will also find in the online learning portal two ‘modules’ that include curriculum links and downloadable resources to accompany these student modules.



